COMPANY PROFILE

TexAmericas Center Rail Car Services is a business unit of TexAmericas Center, which is headquartered in the Texarkana MSA in Texas. TAC Rail provides storage, freight movement, switch and tender services on-site to over 30 miles of TAC-owned rail.

Limited transload activity has been performed at TexAmericas Center; however, interest exists in expanding this service. A Technical Assistance Grant award to TexAmericas Center in 2016 by the Economic Development Administration produced a preliminary report indicating the potential to upgrade the former army transload facility on the TexAmericas Center East Campus into a fully functioning rail service site.

The Union Pacific (UP) has the largest presence in the area with an active switch yard located in Texarkana, AR-TX, which builds approximately 30 unit-sized trains daily and has a maximum capacity of 750 cars. The UP track, which connects to Red River Army Depot and TexAmericas Center at the north, is leased to Texas Northeastern Railroad (TNER, a Genesee & Wyoming company). The TNER interchanges directly with TAC Rail. The UP also has track that connects to TexAmericas Center owned rail on the East Campus from the south.

- Manifest or unit trains can be received at TAC Rail.
- Maximum number of cars to be spotted at one time is dependent upon availability of space at site.
- No limitations due to locomotive power availability.
- TexAmericas Center has been in operation for 20 years and performs all rail maintenance, replacing approximately 3,000 railroad ties per year.
- TexAmericas Center does not have permitting, zoning or regulation requirements.
- Temporary transload services available.
