STATE OF TEXAS WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE

Texas is the only state that does not require employers to have workers' compensation. In 2020 the national average cost of workers compensation insurance was \$1.19 per \$100 of payroll, according to the National Academy of Social Insurance. In Texas that cost was \$0.46 per \$100 of payroll. The Texas average for manufacturers in 2024 was \$0.55 per \$100 of payroll and ranged from \$0.50 to \$3.00+ per \$100 of payroll. The maximum benefit is currently \$913.00.

In 2024, Texas law sets a new employer's Unemployment tax rate at their NAICS industry average or 2.7 percent, whichever is higher.

THE TEXAMERICAS CENTER LOGISTICS ADVANTAGE

Texarkana is the closest Texas community to the geographic and population centers of the U.S. This distinction makes our industrial park the lowest aggregate mile location in Texas to reach the USA and North American markets. I-30: TexAmericas Center is located along I-30. TexAmericas Center's most central interchange is within 0.5 miles of the property and it is about two hours travel time along I-30 from both Dallas (west) and Little Rock (east).

I-69/-369: Interstate I-69/I-369 is within 8 miles of TexAmericas Center and is about 5.5 hours north of Houston on US 59 (now I-69/I-369). I-69 also connects with all Texas ports on the Gulf of Mexico. A proposed extension off I-369 will run northwest through the TexAmericas Center Industrial Park and swing northeast and connect to I-49 north of Texarkana.

I-49: TexAmericas Center is within 13 miles of I-49 and is approximately 6.5 hours north of New Orleans on I-49. To the north, roughly 125 miles of I-49 are still under construction. This interstate will link Texarkana to Kansas City and its connections to Canada and beyond.

TexAmericas Center is served by a line owned by the UP and operated by the TNER; rail service is possible on our Central and East Campuses. The TNER presently offers service three days per week. TexAmericas Center owns and operates, via TACRail, about 38 miles of rail, a 350-car classification yard, and two locomotives on our East Campus. TACRail provides: Storage, Spotting, MRO, and Transload services. TAC Rail currently offers service five days a week during standard business hours but will adjust staffing to meet any need.

TexAmericas Center is well-equipped to execute the requirements of BTS projects. Our experience includes the recent completion of a 150,000-square-foot spec building, with 32-foot clear-height ceilings, one dock door per 5,000 square feet, and 7" reinforced floors. The building was a 10-month build that sold in December 2022.

Our construction experience includes five greenfield projects, totaling over 335,000 square feet, as well as managing a lease portfolio of over 1.4 million square feet of property, much of which we have retrofitted to meet tenant needs. TexAmericas Center Staff and Board of Directors understands that "Shovel-Ready" sites can give communities seeking to attract quality jobs, a strong competitive advantage.

Our "Shovel-Ready" sites have gone through an extensive review process and are designated as prime locations for economic development projects to occur. We call this process our Qualified Sites Program (QSP). Administered by our COO, who is a PE, we have compiled a full report on each designated property.

A property that has gone through our QSP has undergone a rigorous level of scrutiny to confirm that the site is adjacent to utilities typically needed for commercial and/or industrial operations, that site characteristics are conducive to business activities, that any encumbrances that might impact the property are known and that key approvals, documentation, regulations and assessments required for commercial or industrial uses are known and in place. The QSP documents provide key specs, like utility capacity, transportation assets, location advantages, soil information, results of specialized reports, total acreage and cost per acre, and types of businesses the site can accommodate, along with an aerial view of the property showing lot lines, roads, sewers and other infrastructure and transportation data points. By having Shovel-Ready sites available, TexAmericas Center will be able to better accommodate the needs and desires of prospective businesses. Companies that have immediate space and/or time requirements will have access to a greater amount of information potentially decreasing the chances of risks or constraints that could delay or derail a project.

Beyond time savings, QSP sites minimize risk by ensuring that businesses are dealing with a "known quantity," reducing uncertainties and potential delays during development. By addressing these critical factors upfront, the program helps companies avoid costly surprises and streamline the development process.
